During the weekend there will be a frequent train service from both Buckfastleigh (large free car park) and Totnes (mainline connections). Parking is very limited at Staverton so please use the train to reach Staverton. At least four different locomotives are expected to be in use hauling trains on each day. Proceeds from the festival will help with the restoration of Class 50 locomotive D402, and with the ongoing upkeep and maintenance of the station.
