Wine & PIMMS

There will be the usual PIMMS tent (run by the Worcester Loco Society), and new for 2016, a small wine bar serving a selection of wines, plus some ale and cider, both of which will be located in the main station yard area during daylight hours (except Friday) Soft drinks can also be purchased from the wine bar, main bar and from the buffet coach located at the station.

Ale and Ciders will be priced at £3.00 per pint / £1.50 per half pint. Proceeds go towards the restoration and maintenance of the Society's heritage diesel locomotives. The festival is open from 11.00 each day until 23.00 (18.00 on Monday 29th). There will be evening BBQ's on Friday and Saturday evening, and on Sunday Chilli & Rice will be available. Sunday evening also features a "just for fun quiz". No separate admission charge to the festival - very limited parking at Staverton so please use SDR services from both Buckfastleigh and Totnes to reach Staverton station (frequent services throughout the festival)
