A round trip ticket is valid for travel all day, on all our trains, so you can ride as many trains as much as you like! See if you can get a ride behind each of the four locomotives in operation today! Be sure to also take a ride on the heritage GWR auto trains which are in operation all day, including, for part of the day, the 'auto sandwich', where the locomotive will be sandwiched between two auto carriages! The views of the line from the front vestibule are not to be missed!

**Nappers Halt is a request stop.** Passengers wishing to alight should advise the guard before the train departs from the previous station. Passengers wishing to board should give a clear and prominent handsignal to the driver from the platform.

Trains headed 'A' are worked by heritage auto-train and are formed of one coach only.

Trains headed 'S' are worked by heritage auto-train and are formed of two coaches only.
