GWR(2) 2 coach GWR local set formed of 7377 + 6515 (Wheelchair access available)

GWR(3) 3 coach GWR passenger set formed of 7377 + 6515 + 1295 (Wheelchair access available)

GWR (4) 4 coach GWR passenger set formed of 7377 + 6515 + 1295 + 536 (Wheelchair access available)

GWR (5) 5 coach GWR passenger set formed of GWR (4) + Special saloon 9005 added on Ashburton end

GWR (7) 7 coach GWR passenger set formed of GWR (4) + Super Saloons 9111 “King George” & 9116 “Duchess of York” & Special saloon 9005 on Ashburton end.

Auto (1) Single car auto train formed with either crimson trailer W225 or Crimson & Cream trailer W228 (Wheelchair access)

Auto (2) Two-car auto train service formed of both W225 + W228 (Wheelchair access)

Mk 1's 5 coach British Railways Mark 1 set formed of 43147 + 1917 (Buffet) + 4496 + 4962 + 4805 (Real Ale Bar)

Spl (3) All first class GWR special formed of Super saloons 9111 + 9116 and special saloon 9005

Non Passenger Trains

Vic'n (2) 2 coach Victorian train formed of Clerestory coaches 7 & 249

Goods Trains

Gds (G) Great Western & Private Owner wagon train formed of GWR Toad brake van and 7 other vehicles

Gds (B) British Railways era goods train formed of appropriate era and liveried wagons running as 8 and 10 wagon rakes.

Gs B+G Both goods trains combined to form 16 and 18 wagon trains
